

Regulations for taking the examination

2. Late arrivals of up to 30 minutes will be admitted after the scheduled start of the examination. Please contact the Admissions Office Nakamozu Campus.

If a person is late due to special circumstances on the day of the examination (reasons in the addendum), there are cases where that person can be approved to start the test up to 60 minutes past the official starting time and have the examination time extended. Therefore, please contact the Admissions Office Nakamozu Campus.

- More than 30 minutes delay by suspension of the public transportation such as train, subway, bus, etc. (which operates according to timetables only) by the accidents.
- The delay by unexpected accidents, injuries, diseases on the way to the venue.

3. Electronic devices like cellular phones, smartphones, wrist watches with information access functions must have their alarms turned off and be powered down before entering the examination room. They should be placed in a person's bag along with other items. If a person is carrying these items without putting them into their bag during the examination, this could be considered as cheating.
