If the applicant is deemed to have met the criteria for tenure review at or after the interim review in the third year, the timing of the final review may be moved up.A safety-net provision will allow Tenure-Track faculty members to remain employed for up to 3 years in the case they fail to be promoted at the time of the 5-year evaluation.
